# **Course Descriptions**

## Art 7/8/9

#### Semester Course (\$15.00 fee)

In this creative course, you'll dive into a variety of art materials and processes. You'll explore mediums like pastels, paint, printmaking, and clay sculpture, while developing an appreciation for art from different cultures around the world. For advanced students, the course provides opportunities to work in greater detail and explore developmental drawing, painting, and sculpture. Whether you're just starting or have previous experience, there's always room to grow and express your artistic side!

## **Band-Instrumental Music 7/8/9**

#### Full Year Course (\$40.00 fee)

Get ready to rock! This full-year course introduces you to the world of musical performance, where you'll learn the basics of technique, breathing, music notation, ensemble playing, and music theory. You'll have the option to play a woodwind, brass, or percussion instrument, and explore a variety of musical styles. Performance opportunities include evening concerts, instrument clinics, and even Junior Jazz Band. A previous Band course is required for Grade 8 and 9 students or permission from the teacher.

## Drama 7/8/9

#### Semester Course (No Fee)

Explore life through drama! This course encourages students to express themselves through movement, speech, improvisation, and technical theatre. You'll build confidence and creativity while learning the skills needed to create and perform in dramatic works. Whether you're acting on stage or working behind the scenes, drama is all about embracing your creativity and developing your dramatic skills.

## French as a Second Language 7/8/9

#### Full Year Course (No fee)

Join our French language classes and explore the world of bilingual communication! In this course, you'll learn to read, write, speak, and listen in French, all while connecting with the cultural richness of the language. French 7 is a prerequisite for French 8, and French 8 is a prerequisite for French 9, so be sure to start your journey in Grade 7 to continue building your skills and proficiency.



## **Environmental and Outdoor Education 7**

#### Semester Course (\$6.00 fee)

This course focuses on environmental awareness and the importance of respecting our planet. You'll learn about local wildlife, global environmental issues, and how we can all make a difference. You'll also dive into the history of conservation efforts and environmentalism. As well, this course will help you prepare for the Alberta Hunter Training and Conservation Education Course—an essential for first-time hunters in Alberta!

## General Music 7/8/9

#### Semester Course (\$10.00 fee)

If you've ever wanted to understand how music works, this course is for you! You'll dive into the basics of music literacy and explore core elements like melody, rhythm, harmony, and form. Through handson activities, including drumming and strumming, you'll apply what you've learned and explore the evolution of music across cultures and history.

## **Musical Theatre 8/9**

#### Semester Course (\$30.00 fee)

Ready to perform on stage? In this interactive course, you'll study movement, dance, acting, singing, and technical theatre. You'll work with your classmates to put on a musical showcase production, gaining experience in all aspects of the theatrical world—from rehearsals to the final performance. Both on-stage and off-stage opportunities will be available--it takes a whole team to put on a show!

#### Semester Course (No fee)

#### Semester Course (No fee)







## **CTF: Fitness and Wellness 7/8/9**

#### Semester Course (\$5.00 fee)

A healthy mind and body are key to success—and this course is all about helping you get there. You'll explore nutrition, stress management, time management, and how to make responsible, healthy choices. As part of the course, you'll create a personalized fitness plan to meet your goals and stay on track. Be ready to work out and break a sweat as you focus on being healthy, happy, and productive!

## **CTF: Foods 7/8/9**

#### Semester Course (\$38.00 fee)

Want to improve your cooking skills and learn some important life skills? This course covers food safety, kitchen tools, measurement, and the basics of nutrition. You'll practice essential cooking techniques, learn how to read and understand recipes, and develop good habits in the kitchen. ## **CTF: Leadership 9**

#### Semester Course (\$5.00 fee)

## **CTF: Personal Style & Image Design 7**

#### Semester Course (\$15.00 fee)

## **CTF: Sports Acceleration 9**

#### Semester Course (\$170.00 fee)

At the core of Sports Acceleration is personal and community health & wellness: fitness, nutrition, physical and mental well-being. But you will also explore sports psychology (mental acuity, mental preparation), sports medicine (injury prevention and management), and athletic leadership (team roles and team dynamics. This is a course for EVERYONE—not just those who are athletically-inclined!



## **CTF: The World of Food 9**

#### Semester Course (\$24.00 fee)

In this course, you'll embark on a culinary journey, exploring regional cuisines from around the world. Discover how geography, history, and culture influence cooking traditions and techniques. You'll also have the opportunity to try various ethnic foods and learn about the cultural significance behind each dish.

## **CTF: Computer Science 7/8/9**

#### Semester Course (\$8.00 fee)

Are you ready to dive into coding and game design? In this course, you'll learn what it takes to create and develop your own video game, animated story, interactive art, and more! Design characters, plotlines, and adventures—all inside a world that's entirely your creation. By the end of Grade 9, you'll have your very own video game to show off!

## **CTF: Enterprise and Innovation 8/9**

#### Semester Course (No fee)

This course is perfect for those who like to think outside the box. You'll learn the ins and outs of project management, from brainstorming ideas to executing and reflecting on your own project or innovation. Whether you're exploring new business ideas or creating something entirely unique, this course will help you turn your concepts into reality. This is a required course for all Grade 8&9 Honours students.

## **CTF: Robotics 8**

#### Semester Course (\$15.00 fee)

If you love coding and want to learn about programming and circuitry, this class is for you! Build LEGO NXT robots that can do all sorts of amazing things—racing cars, battling scorpions, or even creating roller coasters! The possibilities are endless as you explore the world of robotics and develop your very own creations.

## **CTF: Communication Arts & Media Relations 9**

#### Semester Course (\$12.00 fee)

## **CTF: Creative Design and Production 7**


## **CTF: Film Production 9**

#### Semester Course (No fee)


